- The concept of having a "wide open" meeting for the Java and Jakarta EE community in general was discussed. It may be too late for this meeting, and potentially muddying Jakarta EE 11 launching activities, but we would like to discuss in future meetings a broader community meeting.

#### **Discussion of Replacement Enterprise Member Representative**

- As discussed last time, Reza Rahman has left Microsoft, and his seat as Enterprise Member representative to the Steering Committee is now vacant.
- Note from the Eclipse Foundation:

Reza was elected as the Enterprise Rep to the Steering Committee, so he was elected as an Individual. The seat does not belong to Microsoft. We can all refer to the Ops Guide for greater information on this

Note that as defined in the Eclipse Bylaws and Eclipse Foundation Working Group Process, individuals are elected to committees (and not the member organisation). That is, the governing body is composed of individuals (natural persons). The net result is that the member organisation of the elected representative does not get to appoint someone else as the elected representative if, for example, their employee leaves their company. Instead, it is the governing body's (in this case Steering and Marketing Committee) decision whether to leave the seat vacant or request the Eclipse Foundation to call an election to fill the seat for an interim period. While the seat is vacant, it will not count towards achieving quorum.

- Last meeting the Steering Committee discussed briefly whether we want the seat filled via an election process prior to the standard election cycle in the September timeframe. The standard process for electing Enterprise Member representatives would be used. There was consensus that we give Committee members the chance to consider the issue, and vote during this week's meeting on whether to request an election.
- The following resolution was voted on:

RESOLVED, that the Jakarta EE Steering Committee requests that the Eclipse Foundation call an election to fill the recently vacated Enterprise Member representative seat on the Jakarta EE Steering Committee, for an interim period until the next election cycle in the fall of 2025.


#### **Charter/Fee Update**
