Note that as defined in the Eclipse Bylaws and Eclipse Foundation Working Group Process, individuals are elected to committees (and not the member organisation). That is, the governing body is composed of individuals (natural persons). The net result is that the member organisation of the elected representative does not get to appoint someone else as the elected representative if, for example, their employee leaves their company. Instead, it is the governing body's (in this case Steering and Marketing Committee) decision whether to leave the seat vacant or request the Eclipse Foundation to call an election to fill the seat for an interim period. While the seat is vacant, it will not count towards achieving quorum.

- The Steering Committee should discuss whether we want the seat filled. I recommend we discuss briefly, give Committee members the chance to consider the issue, then vote at the next meeting on whether to request an election.
  - There was group consensus on this approach.
